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# **Network Mapping vs2**

- Two approaches outlined in the guide:
  - Influence Map: shows the people and organizations who influence and make decisions about your Invest Health work; depicts importance, relationship, and influence level
  - Power/Interest Grid: displays the power dynamics at play in your community that impact your team's Invest Health work; information depicted can help inform team's collaboration and communication approach

- Tool to help your team organize and prioritize activities over the coming months
- Map out who is doing what, by when, and how discrete activities contribute to a broader goal

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### **Planning Exercises**

- Core question domains for building a case phase:
  - Vision, Local Context, Community Engagement, and Expected Impact
- Core questions for business planning phase:
  - What do you want to do and why? (Synthesis of team's "building a case" work)
  - What impact do you expect to have on health outcomes and/or equity?
  - Who do you need to implement your plan?
  - What is the timeline for implementation?
  - What is the budget?
  - What are the potential risks and how do you plan to mitigate them?
